## **HOMEWORK**

*Homework forms an essential part of students' learning. It has a number of purposes which consolidate and develop work done in the classroom:*

- *It can re-enforce topics which are studied or serve as preparation for work which will follow*
- *Students have the opportunities to practise skills, concepts and techniques or complete specific projects*
- *They are also given on occasions the opportunity for research and for broadening and extending their horizons*
- *Above all, students have the responsibility to learn independently*
- *In Years 10 and 11, it may form part of GCSE Controlled Assessment preparation*

Deadlines are important as they help students manage their time and keep up-to-date with their work. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that homework is accurately recorded, completed and presented on time.

Work should be of the highest possible quality.

Study/Homework rooms are available in lunchtime and after school.

## YEAR 11 HOMEWORK TIMETABLE 2018-2019

Homework is to be set according to the timetables. During Year 11, it is expected that homework should take about an hour for each subject. Most subjects have homework set once a week, but it may be necessary to set twice a week if a task is to take 30 minutes.

Staff initials are included to show where homework is to be set for that specific group. For Sciences all staff are expected to set homework on the given day.

Each box represents **one** subject within **one** choice, eg Option A: French OR Geography OR Art etc so that students should have a maximum of three subjects on any given day.
