Dear Parent/Guardian

As we progress through a very short half-term, I wanted to write to you all to update you on some key events and also to keep you informed about what is going on in school.

Last week, we conducted 'standards' assemblies for all students in Years 7-11 which focused on school Vision and Values. We also reminded students about behaviours that constitute a serious breach of our Behaviour Policy. Year 10 Careers Programme:

We have been very pleased with the way our Year 10 students have embraced the opportunities to focus on next steps. Following a successful and insightful visit to the Apprenticeship Fair at Colchester Institute, they also took part in a World of Work day last Thursday. Students worked on a variety of projects and tasks related to a field of interest. This included computer game design, sport, journalism, media, business, working in the care industry and Essex Ambulance service. This week students in Year 10 now have their follow up interviews related to their chosen fields. I would like to thank all the outside organisations and employers who have worked with the school on this exciting careers' programme.

Year 9 Guided Choice:

Over the next month our Year 9 students will be selecting their 'options' programme for Year 10.

The process will start week beginning the 18 March, in which there will be a Parents' Virtual Information evening which starts at 5.00 pm. Mr Finch will write to all Year 9 parents with a clear programme and timeline.

Attendance:

As you will have heard in the news recently, the DfE have issued clear guidance related to attendance. As a school, we will be looking closely at our own policy and will ensure that it aligns with central Government. We need to work together with yourselves as parents to ensure that students attend regularly to school. The policy is centred on support and positive relationships but also to make clear the legal requirements, particularly around requests for absence. Attendance will be a consistent feature of communication with parents in the future. We must set high expectations for attendance and punctuality and work together to ensure that we are all aware that regular schooling is significant for a child's attainment, well-being and wider development.
