Year 10 Parents' Information Evening

I am writing to invite you to our Year 10 Parents' Information Evening on **Tuesday 19 May**. This will be a face-to-face event held in the main school hall, beginning at **6.00 pm** and lasting approximately one hour.

In previous years, this evening has taken place at the start of Year 11 and has always been very well attended. This year, we have brought it forward to ensure you have the information needed to support your child as they prepare for their Year 10 mock examinations. With the educational landscape continuing to evolve, it can be difficult to know how best to help students succeed, and we hope this evening will provide clarity, practical strategies, and reassurance.

During the event, we will share the key messages we are giving students about the importance of making the most of the opportunities offered throughout the year. We will outline what these opportunities look like, both in and out of the classroom, and what we expect from students as they move through Key Stage 4. Staff from Maths, English, and Science will deliver short subject-specific presentations, and we will also offer guidance on the Sixth Form application process.

Raising attainment remains a central focus for us at Hedingham. We want every student to leave having made exceptional progress, and parental understanding of exam expectations and effective home support plays a vital role in achieving this. This evening is designed to equip you with the information needed to help your child prepare confidently and effectively.
