Swearing/ Anti-Social Language

We want to make it clear to you today that swearing or anti-social language is not permitted in class, in the corridors or anywhere in the school. That includes in conversations with each other.

If you do use any anti-social language, your parents will be contacted and the exact words you have used will be said to them

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### Keep your phones and headphones out of sight in lessons

You have a right to use your mobile phone at break and lunch in the phone zones.

You have a responsibility not to use it in lessons or between lessons.
You should not film anything or take pictures at any point during the school day.

Headphones should only be used at break and lunch or with your teacher's permission in Computer Science or Music.

Support each other in being responsible digital citizens



Your phone should not be out in class unless specifically directed by the teacher.

Your phone should not be seen in any school corridors.

Headphones/ ear pods should not be worn in class or along corridors at any time.

You should not film anything or take pictures during the school day.

If you choose to use your phone, you will have it confiscated.

Reason	Response
I was just checking the time	Use a clock/ buy a watch or your teacher will tell you when the end of the lesson is.
My parent/ carer was getting in contact	We have written to your parents asking them to contact the front office. You can check your phone at break and lunch.
Medical	We will contact your parents/ carers if needed. You should not use your phone at medical.
I'm using it to check my timetable	Use your planner.

If you use your phone at the incorrect time, your phone will be confiscated and be given to the Student Support Centre



If you need to go to medical, you will be asked to hand in your phone at reception.

We will contact your parents if we need to.

It will be returned to you when you go back to class.



### **Green Slip**


If there is a problem with your uniform


If you are talking with a member of staff

Persistent Disruption in a lesson that continues after your C1 warning.


You have not followed all teacher instructions without question.


You may be asked to leave the classroom so your teacher can speak to you alone.

This is a serious isolated incident, repeated refusal to follow instructions and/ or ongoing persistant disruption.


You will be removed from the classroom to a departmental hotspot.

The Senior Leadership Team and Year Leaders will be informed.


Your parents will be informed.
