

Phase 1 Catch Up Programme - Key Stage 5

Years 12 and 13

The additional support outlined below is Phase One in the approach to support Year 12 and Year 13 students. As further gaps in knowledge emerge, additional strategies will be structured to address student needs.

Firstly, it has been essential to induct Year 12 students as they transition into Hedingham Sixth Form. Teachers have focussed on supporting students to build an appropriate individual programme. It is essential students understand each subject they have selected, the structure and content, and steps to reach success at the end of their two years.

Secondly, progress is being monitored across Years 12 and 13 to identify where gaps are emerging to utilise curriculum time. Appropriate strategies will continue to be put into place, with adjustments to Curriculum Maps where required. Additionally, students are able to attend after school daily for independent study in the Sixth Form Area (3.00-4.00 pm).

Due to examinations taking place this year, Year 13 students have some additional support programmes. Year 13 drop-in support sessions are available across subject areas, delivered by specialists. Students are able to attend extra sessions to revisit and consolidate specific topic areas when required. Please see the structured timetable for further details. Year 13 students are invited to attend Year 12 lessons, allowing the opportunity to revisit topics covered in lockdown and additional support. The Year 12 timetables have been available to all Year 13 students through their subject teachers.

The use of Microsoft Teams is being utilised with home learning resources available across subject areas for both Years 12 and 13. Each subject area contains a bank of work in the file section. This work can be accessed if a student is isolating, or would like to work through additional study tasks.
